

### **ELIGIBILITY OF MEMBERSHIP:**

Membership in the Houston Junior Forum is open to women age twenty (20) years and older. Membership shall not be denied on the basis of race, color, religion, or national origin.

### **FIRST YEAR MEMBER REQUIREMENTS:**

1. The fee for new members is \$150.00 to cover the uniform, yearbook, newsletter, first year member social events, a Fundraising and Development contribution and a HJF Endowment contribution. The annual dues are \$80.00 which are paid after January, with the option to purchase a yearbook which is priced separately.
2. First Year Members are required to provide a minimum of thirty-five (35) hours of service/committee work annually. Twenty (20) of these hours MUST be performed in uniform, at an approved service site. Of these twenty hours, 5 hours will be performed at the HJF Resale Shop, 5 hours at a senior adult center and 5 hours at a school facility. The remaining 5 hours of service may be served at any service site approved by the Board of Directors. The remaining 15 hours may be served at a service site and/or on a HJF committee.
3. First Year Members shall attend three (3) General Meetings each year, June 1 – May 31.
4. These requirements are for 1-6 year members. Seven Year and Beyond Members are not required to do service or attend General Meetings; however, service/committee participation is highly encouraged and is a condition of eligibility for serving in an elected position.

### **RETURNING MEMBER INFORMATION**

As a rejoining member, if you left the Forum in good standing, you are not required to do service or attend General Meetings; however, service/committee participation is highly encouraged and is a condition of eligibility for serving in an elected position.
